ISOLATION

This is one of the most remote places on the planet. KCC has no road access so you have the whole area to yourselves to experience the beauty and peace of our patch of paradise. Just in case though, we do have satellite communications.

EXCLUSIVITY

Because we accommodate a maximum of only 8-14, you are never just 'one of the crowd', but honoured guests in an intimate atmosphere where your needs are paramount - not the demands of a pre-set itinerary. Book with a group of friends and have an exclusive private holiday.

COMFORT

KCC has many amenities not usually expected in remote locations. You can enjoy the isolation without the discomfort. Your room with a view has a double bed or twin, electric light, flyscreen's and ceiling fan, while the unique showers and flushing toilets are built against a natural rock wall.

CUISINE

Fresh is best. Based on lots of fresh ingredients, homemade breads and delectable desserts, our gourmet chef will prepare your 'catch of the day' to enjoy at the 'Big House'. Enjoy a cold drink with an entrée around the camp fire while looking out over the Admiralty Gulf.

At KCC we specialise in organising activities to suit the interests of our guests. Keen anglers can fish all day, every day, while those who want to explore, sightsee, walk or simply relax are just as well catered for.

WALKING

We have established a number of walking tracks from the camp, which cater for everything from a gentle stroll to a challenging all day hike. Billabongs, caves, birds, wildlife and ancient aboriginal rock art are all a feature. Walks are fully guided by our knowledgeable staff.





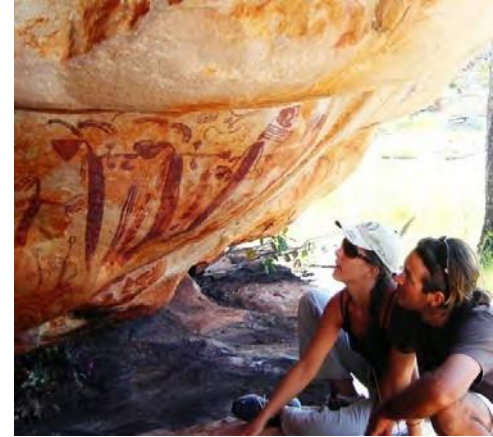
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ROCK ART

Kimberley Coastal Camp is at the centre of one of the world's finest repositories of indigenous rock paintings – many only a short walk from the camp or the boat. Marvel at the elegant and ancient Gwion Gwion (Bradshaw) paintings whose origins are lost in time. Sit in a cave decorated with thousands of tiny paintings – and others guarded by huge Wandjinas with their radiating headdresses.

Visit ceremonial sites which continue to have great significance to our traditional landowners. These extraordinary sites are only accessible by boat or on foot so remain untouched. We are very fortunate to have access to them.



FLYING PICNICS

For those who want to visit otherwise inaccessible rock art sites, fish some really secret spots or just see more of this fascinating country, we can arrange a helicopter charter to take you to places only a very few lucky visitors have ever seen. For a couple of hours or a whole day you can experience the exhilaration of exploring by air and landing at a remote waterfall for a swim and gourmet lunch.



BEACHCOMBING

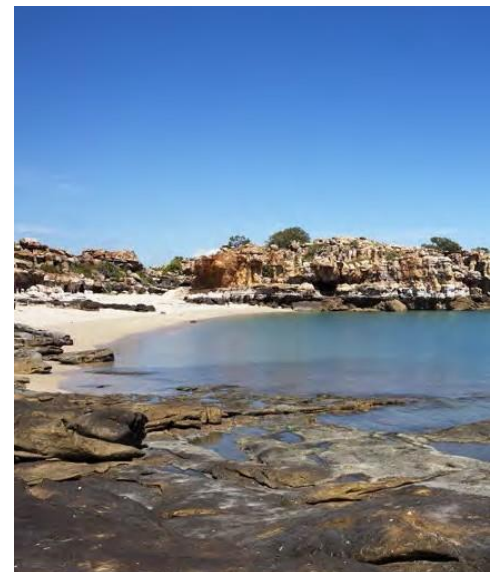
A short cruise by boat from the camp are numerous untouched beaches and islands where guests can go ashore and explore, picnic under a boab tree, find a special shell or piece of coral, or just enjoy the view.

Because of our unique location, we have access to a number of different habitats - either by land or sea. KCC is an ideal base for keen birdwatchers, naturalists and interested amateurs alike. A bird list is available on request.





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FISHING

Kimberley Coastal Camp offers a luxurious alternative to other fishing camps.

Kimberley Coastal Camp is situated in the remote Admiralty Gulf in the north Kimberley where the fishing is truly magnificent.

Because of our isolation - with access only by boat or air - these really are untouched waters.

Options available to our guests include huge tidal rivers, mangrove creeks, estuaries, mud flats, offshore reefs and islands.

Some of the species to be caught include barramundi, mulloway, mangrove jack, fingermark, javelin fish, threadfin salmon (giant and blue), giant, golden and spotted trevally, queen fish, mackerel, tuna, coral trout, cod and bluebone.

Because of our unique location, there is also an abundance of mud crabs and oysters.

Kimberley Coastal Camp operates on a catch and release basis, with only those fish destined for the table being retained from the day's catch.

We supply fishing gear however you are welcome to bring your own favourite rod and reel if you prefer. We offer overhead/ baitcaster and threadline/ spinning reels with rods to match. We run quality braid fishing line on these reels and promote responsible fishing practices.

BOATS

Our purpose built and fully surveyed 7.5 m boat has much to offer anglers who are not interested in spending long hours in the sun fishing from a dinghy. The special design allows for maneuvering in tight and shallow spots, lots of fishing and casting space - and shade as well. We also have a 5.0 m sports fishing tender set up for fishing the mangrove creeks and a brand new 6.0 m custom built Westerberg suitable for blue water fishing and mangrove creeks.





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GENERAL INFORMATION

GETTING TO KIMBERLEY COASTAL CAMP

Kimberley Coastal Camp is located on the eastern side Admiralty Gulf. The Mitchell Plateau borders the western side of the Gulf and we are about 10km across the water on the other side.

Kimberley Coastal Camp has no road access and all our guests fly in by chopper from the Mitchell Plateau or via float plane from Kununurra. This flight in itself is often one of our guests' most memorable moments!

If you are driving up to the Mitchell Plateau, packages include helicopter transfers from the Plateau to land on the beach at KCC.

Most of our guests don't have the time and/or the 4WD (or their own aircraft) so they choose a package which includes light aircraft and helicopter flights from Kununurra, Broome, or Darwin.

Commercial airlines run daily flights from Darwin and Broome to Kununurra.

OUR PACKAGES

As all of our guests are unique, everyone enjoys different aspect of what we have on offer. We have taken the advice from previous clients and tailored two different packages to give each person the most during their stay. We offer 2 package types.

The first being a set rate all-inclusive package, where you are able to enjoy all the activities and experiences on offer.

The second giving you the flexibility to pick and choose which activities you would like to experience during your stay.

We have also packaged your nightly rate and activities separately to transfer costs. Transfers are an additional cost and can be allocated with in your travelling group.

Please note only one Package type can be booked for the duration of your stay.





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ONCE HERE, YOUR PACKAGE INCLUDES

Accommodation in unique twin share (or double) rooms with great views, big ceiling fans and 24 hour power.

All meals prepared by our fantastic gourmet chef.

Fully guided activities. We don't have any pre-set itineraries because all our guests are different. You can choose from fishing, bush walking, exploring deserted islands and beaches, visiting ancient rock art sites, learning about our natural and cultural history – or a combination of all or some of these.

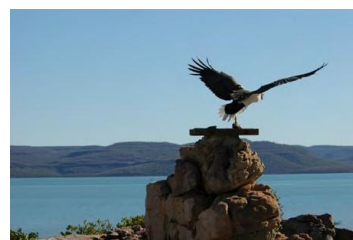
WHEN TO COME TO KIMBERLEY COASTAL CAMP

Kimberley Coastal Camp is open Wet Season or Dry Season; all year round.

If our great fishing is a major attraction for you then speak to us regarding tides. We have all the details so just ask.

The best Barra fishing is traditionally during the wet season, up until June then the middle of September as the weather warms up. However, we catch the elusive barra right through the season, with still an abundance of mulloway, mangrove jack, fingermark, javelin fish, threadfin salmon (giant and blue), giant, golden and spotted trevally, queen fish, mackerel, tuna, coral trout, cod & bluebone.

If walking and exploring is more your thing, then June, July and August are cooler with temps in the low 30s during the day (until the beautiful cool sea breeze arrives around lunchtime) and getting down under 20 at night.



CHILDREN

We don't supply cots, but our rooms can be configured to take an extra Swag Style bed so children can share with their parents.

Depending on your child's size and weight it may be possible to save on chopper transfers by having him/her in a special harness on your lap. We've had many young children travel on a number of occasions this way and they love it!

I'm sure you understand that KCC is a great place for kids, but due to the fact that it is very remote it is paramount for children to be supervised at all times. We ask that you undertake to be responsible for your child's safety and whereabouts 24 hours a day.



AVAILABILITY

We are currently accepting bookings for 2016 & 2017.

We limit numbers to 8 - 14 guests at a time, so you get to experience our beautiful patch of remote wilderness without meeting hundreds of other people - and feeling like the wilderness has disappeared somewhere else! We are also very conscious of maintaining the pristine nature of the country and minimising our ecological footprint.
